

Resolution Amending the By Laws of the  
Irish Heritage Society

RESOLVED, that the Bylaws of the Irish Heritage Society, as restated October, 2010, be amended to remove term limits on Board Members and Officers, to which end, Article V, Section 3 and Article VI, Section 1 be and they hereby are amended to read as follows:

“Article V, Section 3: The Board shall elect the officers of the Society. These officers shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer and will be known as “Officers”. Such officers shall serve a two (2) year term.

Article VI, Section 1. Number and Tenure: 10-14 Directors will be elected to the Board for a two (2) year term. Directors serving on the effective date of these Bylaws shall continue in office for the duration of their elected term with future elections staggered so that half the Directors shall be elected each year.”
